ASSIGNMENT

WHEREAS, Lawrence J. Svabek, residing at 14624 Crystal Tree Drive, Orland Park 60462; Leonard J. Svabek, residing at 11820 Arbor Drive, Orland Park 60467; and Richard J. Svabek, residing at 65 Stone Creek Drive, Lemont, IL 60439 (hereinafter "Assignors"), have invented certain new and useful improvements in an IN-FRAME WIRE FRY BASKET (hereinafter "invention") for which Assignors are making or has made application for LETTERS PATENT OF THE UNITED STATES, which application has been duly executed by Assignors on date(s) listed below.

WHEREAS, Archer Wire International Corporation, a corporation organized and existing under the laws of the State of Illinois, U.S., having a place of business at 7300 S. Assignee will hold all rights for its own use and benefit and for the use and benefit of its successors or assigns to the full end of the term for which the LETTERS PATENT may be granted, as fully and entirely as the same would have been held and enjoyed by Assignors if this assignment and sale had not been made. Assignor requests and authorizes the Commissioner of Patents and Trademarks, U.S. and its foreign counterparts, to issue the LETTERS PATENT when granted, in accordance with this assignment.

Assignors further covenant and agree with the Assignee that Assignor has a full and unencumbered title to the invention, which title Assignors warrants to the Assignee. Assignors further agree that the Assignors will, without demanding any further consideration therefor, at the request and expense of the Assignee, do all lawful and just acts, including the execution and acknowledgement of instruments, that may be or become necessary for obtaining sustaining, extending, reissuing or reexamining United States and foreign LETTERS PATENT or the like for the invention, and for maintaining

and perfecting the Assignee's right to the invention and LETTERS PATENT, particularly in cases of interference conflict, opposition and litigation.


