**ASSIGNMENT**

WHEREAS, we, **Min-Hyo, SEO**, resident of Korea, whose postal mailing address is Soojeong Town 32-1008, Doonsan 2-dong, Seo-ku, Taejeon, 302-775, Republic of Korea, **In-Ja, CHOI**, resident of Korea, whose postal mailing address is 63-2, Wham-dong, Yuseong-ku, Taejeon, 305-348, Republic of Korea, and **Young-Hoon, CHO**, resident of Korea, whose postal mailing address is Damoa APT. #102-1407, 311 Wolpyung 3-dong, Seo-ku, Taejeon, Republic of Korea (hereinafter "Assignors") have invented a certain new and useful improvement in a **POSITIVELY CHARGEABLE AMPHIPHILIC BLOCK COPOLYMER AS DRUG CARRIER AND COMPLEX THEREOF WITH NEGATIVELY CHARGED DRUG** for which an application for United States Letters Patent is being filed concurrently herewith on January 14, 2004 as THORPE NORTH & WESTERN L.L.P. We hereby authorize and request the United States Commissioner of Patents and Trademarks, and such Patent Office officials in foreign countries as are duly authorized by their patent laws to issue patents, to issue any and all Letters Patent on said invention to the said Assignee as the owner of our entire interest, for the sole use and behoof of the said Assignee, its successors, assigns and legal representatives, to the full end of the term for which said Letters Patent may be granted, as fully and entirely as the same would have been held by us had this assignment and sale not been made.

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


