ASSIGNMENT FOR APPLICATION FOR PATENT

WHEREAS: Revicci, Inc., whose address is 5 Fordham Road, Livingston, New Jersey 07039 (hereinafter referred to as Assignor), owns a right, title and interest in and to a certain invention entitled FRAGRANCE FRIENDLY AND COST EFFECTIVE ANTIPERSPIRANT ACTIVES AND METHOD OF MAKING THE SAME for which an application for Letters Patent of the United States is being filed concurrently herewith;

1. Said Assignor hereby sells, assigns, transfers and conveys to Assignee the full and exclusive right, title and interest in and to said Application and said Invention; in and to all rights to apply for foreign patents on said Invention pursuant to the International Convention for the Protection of Industrial Property or otherwise; in and to any and all Applications filed and any and all Patents granted on said Invention in the United States, any foreign country or any group of countries, including each and every Application filed and each and every Patent granted on any application which is a division, substitution, or continuation of said Application, and in and to each and every reissue or extension of any of said Patents.
2. Said Assignor hereby covenants and agrees to cooperate with said Assignee to enable said Assignee to enjoy to the fullest extent the right, title and interest to said Invention herein conveyed in the United States, foreign countries and groups of countries. Such cooperation by said Assignor shall include prompt production of pertinent facts and documents, giving testimony, execution of petitions, oaths, specifications, declarations or other papers, and other assistance all to the extent deemed necessary or desirable by said Assignee for perfecting in said Assignee the right, title and interest herein conveyed; for prosecuting any of said applications; for filing and prosecuting substitute, divisional, continuing or additional applications covering said Invention; for filing and prosecuting applications for reissuance of any of said Patents; for interference or other priority

proceedings involving said Invention; and for legal proceedings involving said Invention and any applications therefor and any Patents granted thereon, including without limitation opposition proceedings, cancellations proceedings, priority contests, public use proceedings, infringement actions and court actions; provided, however, that the expense incurred by said Assignor in providing such cooperation shall be paid for by said Assignee.

3. The term and covenants of this agreement shall inure to the benefit of said Assignee, its successors, assigns and other legal representatives, and shall be binding upon said Assignor, his respective heirs, legal representatives and assigns.
4. Said Assignor hereby warrants and represents that he has not entered and will not enter into any assignment, contract, or understanding in conflict herewith, and that he has the right to make this Agreement.
