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## Assignment of Invention and Patent Application

THIS AGREEMENT dated Nov 19 2004 is made BETWEEN:

- (4) any applications which are continuations, continuations-in part, substitutes, divisions and extensions of the above-identified application.

2. Assignor authorizes and requests the Commissioner for Patents to issue any resulting patent(s) as following: 0% to Assignor and 100% to Assignee. (The singular shall include the plural and *vice versa* herein.)



4. Further, Assignor agree that I will communicate to Assignee or its


