## ASSIGNMENT

WHEREAS, **Anthony G. Micele, Jr.** (hereinafter "MR. MICELE"), now deceased and late of Kenosha, Wisconsin, and **Francois P. Delcourt**, residing at 1909 West Barry Avenue, Chicago, Illinois 60657, did jointly make an invention for which application for Letters Patent of the United States of America was filed in the United States Patent and Trademark Office as Application No. **10/632,164** on **August 1, 2003**, and entitled "**Luminary Product**";

WHEREAS, **S.C. Johnson & Son, Inc.** (hereinafter "ASSIGNEE"), a corporation duly organized and existing under the laws of the State of Wisconsin, United States of America and having its principal office and place of business at 1525 Howe Street, Racine, Wisconsin 53403, is desirous of obtaining MR. MICELE's entire right, title, and interest in and to the aforesaid invention and patent application and corresponding patent rights worldwide;

WHEREAS, the aforesaid invention was jointly conceived by MR. MICELE and Francois P. Delcourt in the ordinary course of MR. MICELE's employment with ASSIGNEE, and the AGREEMENT TO MAINTAIN SECRECY AND ASSIGN INVENTIONS, dated July 16, 2001, between MR. MICELE and ASSIGNEE, requires MR. MICELE to assign to ASSIGNEE his entire right, title, and interest throughout the world in each invention conceived or actually reduced to practice by him in the course of performing under said AGREEMENT;

WHEREAS, MR. MICELE died December 27, 2002; and

WHEREAS, S.C. Johnson & Son, Inc., the court-appointed **Special Administrator** of the estate of MR. MICELE (hereinafter "Estate"), is MR. MICELE's legal representative (hereinafter "ASSIGNOR");

NOW, THEREFORE, for good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged, ASSIGNOR, in its capacity as legal representative, does hereby sell, assign, and transfer to ASSIGNEE the Estate's entire right, title, and interest in and to the aforesaid invention, the aforesaid U.S. and all corresponding foreign patent applications, all divisional, continuation, continuation-in-part, reissue, and reexamination applications of the aforesaid U.S. application, and all Letters Patent or comparable rights issuing thereon in the United States and in all foreign countries together with the right of priority under the International Convention for the Protection of Industrial Property, Inter-American Convention Relating to Patents, Designs and Industrial Models, and any other international agreements to which the United States of America adheres, and ASSIGNOR hereby authorizes and requests the U.S. Commissioner of Patent and Trademarks and all foreign Patent offices to issue all Letters Patent or comparable rights issuing on any application as aforesaid to ASSIGNEE, or to its successors, assigns or legal representatives;

AND ASSIGNOR HEREBY covenants that it has the full right to convey the entire interest herein assigned, and that it has not executed, and will not execute, any agreement in conflict herewith;

AND ASSIGNOR HEREBY consents that a copy of this assignment shall be deemed a full and formal equivalent of any assignment, consent to file, or like document which may be required in any country or region for any purpose;

AND ASSIGNOR HEREBY agrees to communicate to ASSIGNEE or to its successors, assigns or legal representatives any and all facts known to ASSIGNOR respecting said invention, and without further remuneration to testify in any legal proceeding, sign all lawful papers, execute all divisional, continuation, continuation-in-part, reissue and reexamination applications, make all rightful oaths and generally do all lawful acts to aid ASSIGNEE or its successors, assigns or legal representatives to obtain and enforce proper patent protection for said invention in all countries and to enhance or perfect ASSIGNEE's title in and to the invention and patent rights therein.

The person signing this instrument on behalf of the Special Administrator, S.C. Johnson & Son, Inc., is Melissa D. Morris, who is a citizen of the United States of America and resident of Franklin, Wisconsin, having a post office address of 3560 West Thorncrest Drive, Franklin, Wisconsin 53132, and who is a Human Resources Manager of S.C. Johnson & Son, Inc., and duly authorized and empowered to act on behalf of S.C. Johnson & Son, Inc., in executing this instrument.


