2004 GRANT OF SECURITY INTEREST

(PATENTS)

THIS 2004 GRANT OF SECURITY INTEREST, dated as of September 24, 2004, is executed by CHIEF MANUFACTURING, INC., a Massachusetts corporation ("CMI"), in favor of WELLS FARGO BANK, NATIONAL ASSOCIATION, a national banking association, as Administrative Agent for the Lenders referenced below ("Administrative Agent").

A. Pursuant to that certain Credit Agreement, dated as of August 29, 2003 (as the same from time to time hereafter may be amended, modified, supplemented or restated, the "Credit Agreement"), by and among CMI as successor by merger to Chief Manufacturing Acquisition Corp., a Delaware corporation, Chief Manufacturing Holding Corp., a Delaware corporation, the financial institutions party thereto from time to time (collectively, the "Lenders") and Wells Fargo Bank, National Association, as Administrative Agent, L/C Issuer, Swing Line Lender and a Lender, the Lenders have agreed to extend loans and other financial accommodations to CMA for the purposes, and on the terms and subject to the conditions, set forth in the Credit Agreement.

B. CMI owns the letters patent, and/or applications for letters patent, of the United States and certain foreign countries, more particularly described on Schedule 1 annexed hereto and made a part hereof (collectively, the "Patents").

C. CMI has entered into a Security Agreement (Intellectual Property) dated as of August 29, 2003 (the "IP Security Agreement") with Administrative Agent.

D. Pursuant to the IP Security Agreement, CMI has assigned and granted to Administrative Agent on behalf of the Lenders a security interest in all right, title and interest of CMI in and to the Patents, together with any reissue, continuation, continuation-in-part or extension thereof, and all proceeds thereof, including any and all causes of action which may exist by reason of infringement thereof (the "Collateral"), to secure the prompt payment, performance and observance of the Secured Obligations (as defined in the IP Security Agreement).

NOW, THEREFORE, for good and valuable consideration, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, CMI does hereby further assign, transfer and convey unto Administrative Agent on behalf of the Lenders and grant to Administrative Agent on behalf of the Lenders a security interest in the Collateral to secure the prompt payment, performance and observance of the Secured Obligations.

CMI does hereby further acknowledge and affirm that the rights and remedies of Administrative Agent with respect to the assignment of and security interest in the Collateral made and granted hereby are more fully set forth in the IP Security Agreement, the terms and provisions of which are hereby incorporated herein by reference as if fully set forth herein.
