ASSIGNMENT

WHEREAS, Antonio MONCLUS, Martin URRUTIA and Juan Manuel VALERO are inventors of an invention subject to United States Patent Application Serial No. 10/426,574 filed April, 30th 2003 and entitled "PRINTING APPARATUS AND METHOD"


