ASSIGNMENT

WHEREAS, the undersigned, Pavel I. Lazarev, a resident of Belmont, California, and Michael V. Paukshto, a resident of Foster City, California, have invented certain new and useful improvements in "*MULTILAYER OPTICAL COATING*", for which invention they have executed application for Letters Patent Serial No. 10/483,193, filed January 8, 2004, and which claims priority to PCT Application Serial No. PCT/US02/23291, filed July 10, 2002 and which further claims priority to Russian Application Serial No. RU 2001118989 filed July 10, 2001.

WHEREAS, OPTIVA, INC. Said Inventors hereby covenant and agree to cooperate with said Assignee to enable said Assignee to enjoy to the fullest extent the right, title and interest herein conveyed in the United States and foreign countries. Such cooperation by said Inventors shall include prompt production of pertinent facts and documents, giving of testimony, execution of petitions, oaths, specifications, declarations or other papers, and other assistance all to the extent deemed


