This assignment and agreement shall be binding upon my heirs and legal representatives.

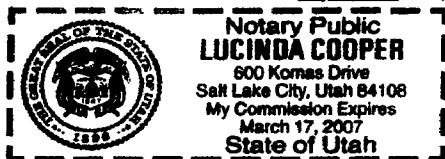
