WHEREAS, I, **Milton J. Allison** may have to sue for damages and other remedies in respect of any infringement of said Letters Patent which may have occurred before the date of this assignment, the same to be held and enjoyed by **The Milton J. Allison Revocable Trust** for its own use and benefit, and for its legal representatives and assigns, to the full end of the term for which said Letters Patent is granted, as fully and entirely as the same would have been held by **Milton J. Allison** had this assignment not been made; and I hereby request the Commissioner of Patents and Trademarks to issue any and all Letters Patent of the United States resulting from said application, now U.S. Patent No. 6,355,242, or from a division, continuation, or reissue thereof, to **The Milton J. Allison Revocable Trust**, as an assignee, for its interest and for the sole use and benefit of **The Milton J. Allison Revocable Trust** and its assigns and legal representatives;

For the same consideration, I, by these presents do sell, assign, and transfer to **The Milton J. Allison Revocable Trust**, the full, exclusive, and entire right, title and interest in and to any foreign application or applications corresponding to said application, now U.S. Patent No. 6,355,242, in whole or in part, in countries other than the United States, in and to any Letters Patent and similar protective rights granted on said foreign applications, and in and to the right to claim any applicable priority rights arising from or required for said foreign applications under the terms of any applicable conventions, treaties, statutes, or regulations; said foreign applications to be filed and issued in the name of **The Milton J. Allison Revocable Trust**, or its designee insofar as permitted by applicable law.

AND, for the same consideration, I agree to sign all lawful papers, execute all division, continuing, reissue and other applications, make all assignments and rightful oaths, and generally do everything possible to aid **The Milton J. Allison Revocable Trust**, its successors, assigns, and nominees, to obtain and enforce proper protection for all said inventions and improvements in all countries throughout the world.

This Assignment is expressly made NUNC PRO TUNC to have the same legal force and effect as if executed on **February 9, 2000**.

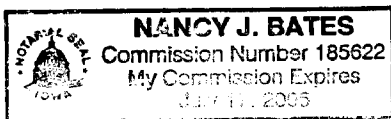
