**TERMINATION AND RELEASE OF PATENT, TRADEMARK AND LICENSE
MORTGAGE**

This TERMINATION AND RELEASE dated as of July 24, 2004, from FLEET NATIONAL BANK, as Agent, (the "Mortgagee") to HOPKINS MANUFACTURING CORPORATION, a Kansas corporation, with its chief executive office and principal place of business at 428 Peyton Street, P.O. Box 1157, Emporia, Kansas 66801 (the "Mortgagor").

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, pursuant to that certain Loan and Security Agreement dated as of February 11, 1997, (the "Security Agreement") the Mortgagor and Fleet Capital Corporation, a Rhode Island Corporation ("Fleet"), as Agent and a Lender, executed a Patent, Trademark and License Mortgage dated as of February 11, 1997, and recorded in the United States Patent and Trademark Office at Trademark Reel 1537 Frame 0041 and Patent Reel 008261 Frame 0924, and any amendments thereto, including the additions recorded at Trademark Reel 1639 Frame 0019; Trademark Reel 2027 Frame 0013; Trademark Reel 2263 Frame 0500; Trademark Reel 2780 Frame 0879; Patent Reel 008723 Frame 0680; Patent Reel 009360 Frame 0200; Patent Reel 010364 Frame 0396; Patent Reel 010547 Frame 0213; and the additions recorded on January 16, 2004, at a Patent Reel and Frame location not yet assigned (the "Mortgage");

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Mortgage, Mortgagor granted, bargained, assigned, mortgaged, created a security interest in, pledged, transferred and conveyed to Fleet by way of a mortgage and security interest, all of Mortgagor's right, title and interest in and to all of its Patents, Trademarks, Licenses (as each are defined in the Mortgage) and goodwill of Mortgagor's business connected with and symbolized by the Trademarks, including without limitation, those patents, patent applications, trademark registrations and applications for trademark registrations listed on the Schedule attached hereto;

WHEREAS, pursuant to that Agency Resignation and Appointment dated as of August 1, 2003, and recorded at Trademark Reel 2816 Frame 0440 and Patent Reel 014409 Frame 0673, the Security Agreement was amended and Mortgagee replaced Fleet as Agent under the Security Agreement;

WHEREAS, the Mortgagee, as Agent, now desires to terminate and release the entirety of its security interest in and reassign all of its rights, title and interest in and to the Patents, Trademarks, Licenses and goodwill;

NOW, THEREFORE, for good and valuable consideration including the satisfaction of all obligations, indebtedness and liabilities secured by the Patents, Trademarks and Licenses pursuant to the Mortgage, the receipt and adequacy of which are hereby acknowledged, and upon the terms set forth in this Termination and Release, the Mortgagee hereby states as follows:

1. Release of Mortgage. The Mortgagee hereby terminates, releases and discharges its security interest in and any and all claims against the Patents, Trademarks, Licenses and

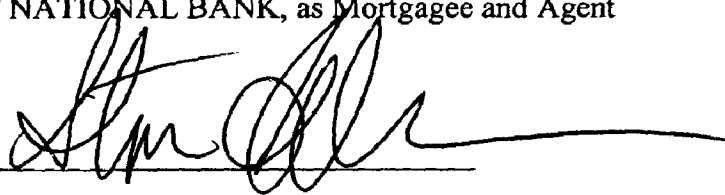
goodwill of Mortgagor's business connected with and symbolized by the Trademarks, and grants, assigns, transfers and conveys to Mortgagor all of its right, title and interest in and to the Patents, Trademarks, Licenses and goodwill of Mortgagor's business connected with and symbolized by the Trademarks.

2. Further Assurances. The Mortgagee hereby confirms that there is currently no Event of Default and agrees to duly execute, acknowledge, procure and deliver any further documents and to do such other acts as may be reasonably necessary to effect the release of the Security Interest contemplated hereby.
