ASSIGNMENT

Whereas I, the undersigned, BRET M. GREER, residing at 1700 Dover Road, Apt. 207A, Delray Beach, Florida 33445, hereinafter referred to as Assignor, did obtain United States Patent No. 6,195,904, issued on March 6, 2001, entitled ADJUSTABLE TILE MEASURING DEVICE;

2. Authorize Assignee to file patent applications in any or all countries on any or all of said related inventions and discoveries in my name or in the name of Assignee or otherwise as Assignee may deem advisable, under the International Convention or otherwise;
3. Authorize and request the Commissioner of Patents and Trademarks of the United States of America and the empowered officials of all other governments to issue or transfer all said Letters Patent to Assignee, as assignee of the entire right, title and interest therein or otherwise as Assignee may direct;
4. Warrant that I have not knowingly conveyed to others any right in said inventions, discoveries, applications or patents or any license to use the same or to make, use or sell anything embodying or utilizing any of said inventions or discoveries; and that I have good right to assign the same to Assignee without encumbrance;
