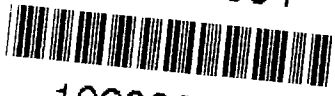

And Assignors do hereby request and authorize the Commissioner of Patents and Trademarks, U.S.A., to issue said additional U.S. LETTERS PATENT, when granted, in accordance with this assignment.
