foreign thereto which have been granted or may be granted on said invention or any part thereof, or on any Acquired Improvements, and in and to and similar protective rights granted on said foreign applications, and in and to the right to claim any applicable priority rights arising from or required for said foreign applications under the terms of any applicable conventions, treaties, statutes, or regulations, said foreign applications to be filed and issued in the name of CHECKPOINT SYSTEMS, INC., or its designee insofar as permitted by applicable law.

CHECKPOINT SYSTEMS INTERNATIONAL GmbH further agrees that all necessary records of CHECKPOINT SYSTEMS INTERNATIONAL GmbH to establish priority of invention in any interference or similar proceeding will be made available at no additional charge to CHECKPOINT SYSTEMS, INC. in the event such records are needed in connection with the assigned application for Letters Patent.

CHECKPOINT SYSTEMS INTERNATIONAL GmbH hereby requests the Commissioner of Patents and Trademarks to issue any and all Letters Patent of the United States resulting in whole or in part from said application, or from any division, continuation or reissue thereof, to CHECKPOINT SYSTEMS, INC., as the assignee, for its interests and for the sole use and benefit of CHECKPOINT SYSTEMS, INC. and its assignees, legal representatives or other designees.
