## ASSIGNMENT

WHEREAS, WE, Hughes Sanoner, citizen of France; Desmond Wai Nang TSE and Ronald Tak Yan YIM both are citizens of Hong Kong, ASSIGNORS, all residing in Hong Kong, are the inventors of the invention entitled **BABY MONITOR**, for which we have executed an original application for a patent of the United States on **30 April 2004**




