ASSIGNMENT OF PATENTS

THIS ASSIGNMENT AGREEMENT entered into this 25th day of November 2004

BETWEEN:

CANADIAN GAS RESEARCH INSTITUTE, a non-profit corporation having a principal place of business at P.O. Box 364, 1920 Ellesmere Road, Suite 104, Toronto, ON M1H 3G1

(hereinafter referred to as the "Assignor")

OF THE FIRST PART

-AND-

LOUISVILLE TIN & STOVE COMPANY, a Kentucky corporation having a principal place of business at 737 South 13th Street, Louisville, Kentucky 40210.

(hereinafter referred to as the "Assignee")

OF THE SECOND PART

WHEREAS, the Assignor has agreed to assign to the Assignee all its right, title and interest in and to Canadian Patent No. 2,066,870 issued on April 14, 1995, and U.S. Patent No. 5,253,635 issued on October 19, 1993 (the "Patents");

AND WHEREAS the Assignee is desirous of acquiring the right to own and use the Patents;

NOW THEREFORE THIS AGREEMENT WITNESSETH that in consideration of the sum of two dollars (\$2.00) of lawful money of the United States of America and other good and valuable consideration now paid by the Assignee to the Assignor, the receipt and sufficiency of which is acknowledged by the Assignor, the parties agree as follows:

1. The Assignor sells, assigns, and transfers to the Assignee the whole right, title and interest of the Assignor in and to the Patents and the registration of the Patents, all of which is to be held as fully by the Assignee as it would have been held by the Assignor had this Assignment not been made.

2. The Assignor warrants to the Assignee that it is the owner of the invention covered by the Patents and that it has the sole right to assign the Patents free from all encumbrances
3. The Assignor covenants and agrees with the Assignee, its successors, and assigns, that it will from time to time and at all times hereafter, upon every reasonable request of, and at the cost of, the Assignee, its successors and assigns, make, do, and execute or cause and procure to be made, done and executed all such further acts, deeds or assurances as may be reasonably required by the Assignee its successors and assigns, for more effectually and completely vesting in the Assignee, its successors and assigns, the Patents sold, assigned and transferred in accordance with the terms of this Assignment.
4. This Agreement shall enure to the benefit of and be binding upon the parties and their respective successors and assigned.


