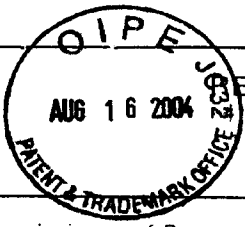

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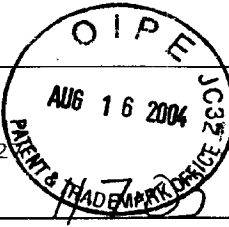

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ASSIGNMENT

WHEREAS, Frank-Peter Schaum and Michael T. McGettigan, residing at 2656 Lenwood Lane, NE, Grand Rapids, Michigan 49525 and 4085 Oak Hollow Court, Muskegon, Michigan 49441, respectively (hereinafter referred to as Assignors), have invented certain new and useful improvements in ADJUSTABLE LENGTH CONVEYOR BED for which a United States provisional application was filed as Serial No. 60/424,421, on November 7, 2002, and for which an application for United States Letters Patent was executed on even date herewith.


