In the event Assignee is unable, after reasonable effort, to secure Assignor's signature on any document or documents needed to

apply for or prosecute any patent, or other right or protection relating to any Assigned Property, for any reason whatsoever, Assignor hereby irrevocably designates and appoints Assignee and its duly authorized officers and agents as Assignor's agent and attorney-in-fact to act for and on Assignor's behalf to execute and file any such application or applications and to do all other lawfully permitted acts to further the prosecution and issuance of patents, or similar protections thereon with the same legal force and effect as if executed by Assignor.
