ASSIGNMENT OF PATENT

Pursuant to Section 2.1 of that certain Asset Purchase Agreement, dated as of October ~~2nd~~ 2003, by and between Perimeter Industries, a corporation incorporated in the State of California, of 1532 W 132nd St, Gardena, California 90249 ("ASSIGNOR"), and Nelson A. Taylor Co., Inc., a New York corporation, of 66 Kingsboro Avenue, Gloversville, NY 12078 ("ASSIGNEE"), for good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which is acknowledged, ASSIGNOR does hereby sell, assign, transfer, convey and deliver to ASSIGNEE all right, title and interest of ASSIGNOR to the entire worldwide right, title and interest in and to the invention known as "jacketed cushioning device and method of manufacture", number 711619, Patent number 5,247,897 dated September 28, 1993 (the "Patent"), and ASSIGNOR further agrees that such assignment includes all goodwill represented thereby and arising from the use thereof, together with all rights to prosecute, register, issue, renew, and maintain in force said Patent and the resulting registration in the United States and all other countries, and all rights to enforce the Patent against infringements in ASSIGNEE's name at ASSIGNEE's expense and for ASSIGNEE's benefit. Furthermore, ASSIGNOR agrees to execute all papers reasonably necessary in connection with any interference which may be declared concerning the Patent and reasonably cooperate with the ASSIGNEE in obtaining evidence and going forward with such interference at no cost or expense to ASSIGNOR and without requirement of the payment of any fees or other amounts by ASSIGNOR.

Furthermore, ASSIGNOR agrees to execute all papers and documents and perform any act which may be reasonably necessary in connection with claims or provisions of the International Convention for Protection of Industrial Property or similar agreements and to perform all affirmative acts which may be reasonably necessary to obtain a grant of a valid United States Patent to the ASSIGNEE, at no cost or expense to ASSIGNOR and without requirement of the payment of any fees or other amounts by ASSIGNOR.

Furthermore, the ASSIGNOR requests the Commissioner of Patents and the Patent Office of any foreign or designated country to issue any and all letters patent of the United States or any foreign or designated country to said ASSIGNEE as ASSIGNEE of the ASSIGNOR'S interest in said Patent.

Furthermore, this instrument shall inure to the benefit of and be binding upon ASSIGNEE, ASSIGNOR, and their lawful representatives, successors and assigns.


