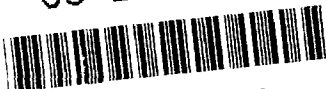

PATENT, PATENT APPLICATION, AND INVENTION ASSIGNMENT

AND Assignor hereby represents, warrants and covenants that it has full right to convey the entire interest herein assigned, and that Assignor has not executed, and will not execute, any agreement in conflict herewith;

AND Assignor further represents, warrants and covenants that it will communicate to Assignee any facts known to it respecting said improvements, and testify in any legal proceeding, sign all lawful papers, execute all divisions, continuation, continuation-in-part, substitute and reissue applications, make all rightful oaths and generally do everything possible to aid Assignee to obtain and enforce proper patent protection for said improvements in all countries.
