PATENT RIGHTS ASSIGNMENT

This Agreement and Assignment, effective as of December 10, 2003, is by and between Alan N. Glazier, having a place of business at 15200 Shady Grove Road, Rockville, Maryland 20850 (hereinafter "Assignor"), and the Sullivan Law Group, having its principal place of business at 1850 North Central Avenue, Suite 1140, Phoenix, Arizona 85004 (hereinafter "Assignee").

Whereas Assignor is the inventor of certain technology relating to ophthalmology and optometry, as more specifically identified herein below; and

Whereas the parties have caused to be filed United States Patent Application entitled "MULTI-FOCAL INTRAOCULAR LENS, AND METHODS FOR MAKING AND USING SAME" filed on December 10, 2003, which is a continuation in part of U.S. Serial No. 10/158,574 (hereinafter the "CIP Patent Application"), which CIP Patent Application represents and comprises certain legal rights regarding patent protection, including but not necessarily limited to the right to seek and possibly to obtain the issuance of patents on the CIP Patent Application, the right to file additional patent applications that rely on the CIP Patent Application for priority, and the right to maintain and enforce the CIP Patent Application and any patents issuing upon them (the "Patent Rights");

Whereas Assignor desires to assign certain right, title and interest in and to the CIP Patent Application and the Patent Rights Assignee for valuable consideration;

Now, therefore, for one dollar and other mutual and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, the parties hereby agree as follows:

1. The "Patent Applications" include the CIP Patent Application, any and all patents issuing thereupon, and any and all continuations, continuations-in-part, divisions, reissues, inventor's certificates, utility models, extensions or modifications of these, or their equivalents. The "Patent Rights" include all of Assignor's right, title and interest in and to the Patent Applications, including any and all rights of priority based upon them, and any and all rights in and to the inventions disclosed in them.

2. Assignor hereby assigns to Assignee a total of Twenty Percent (20%) of Assignor's entire right, title and interest in and to the Patent Applications and the Patent Rights.

3. Assignor and Assignee may further assign their respective rights under this Assignment in whole or in part.
