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## ASSIGNMENT OF PATENT RIGHTS



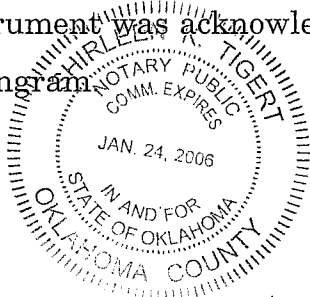
everything possible to aid ASSIGNEE, or its successors, assigns and nominees, to obtain and enforce patent protection for the inventions or improvements in all countries.



**Rotary Union Assembly**

WHEREAS, I, ANTHONY L. INGRAM, a citizen of the United States, (hereinafter "ASSIGNOR"), am the inventor and owner of a certain new and useful invention(s) and improvement(s) entitled "Rotary Union Assembly for use in Air Pressure Inflation Systems for Tractor Trailer Tires"; and,

WHEREAS, AIRGO IP, LLC, a Limited Liability Company duly organized and existing under and by virtue of the laws of the State of Oklahoma (hereinafter ASSIGNEE") is desirous of acquiring and ASSIGNOR is desirous of assigning to ASSIGNEE all right, title and interest in and to said invention, improvements and any patent and patent application thereon in "Rotary Union Assembly for use in Air Pressure Inflation Systems for Tractor Trailer Tires";

4. All applications for patent or like protection on said invention that have now been or may in the future be made by ASSIGNOR or his legal representatives, whether in the United States of America or any other country or place in the world;
5. All patents and like protection that have now been or may in the future be granted on said invention to ASSIGNOR or his legal representatives, whether in the United States of America or in any other country or place anywhere in the world;
6. All substitutions for and divisions, continuations, continuations-in-part, renewals, reissues, extensions, and the like of said applications and patents and like grants, including without limitation, those obtained or permissible under past, present and future laws or statutes;
7. All rights of action on account of past, present and future unauthorized use of said invention and for infringement of said patents and like protection;
8. The right of ASSIGNEE to file in its name applications for patents and like protection

for said invention in any country or countries foreign to the United States of America; and,


9. All international rights or priority associated with said invention, applications, patents and like protection.
