ASSIGNMENT

WHEREAS, Capucine Autret, residing at 283 rue Cherinaz, 74460 Marnaz, France, and Jean-Michel Orsat, residing at Le Pissoir Nord, 74300 Chatillon-Sur-Cluses, France, both citizens of France, hereinafter collectively referred to as ASSIGNOR, have invented and own a certain invention entitled:

METHOD FOR REPROGRAMMING BIDIRECTIONAL OBJECTS

for which a patent application of the United States has been filed on September 8, 2004 and having a Serial No. of 10/506,951; and

ASSIGNOR hereby covenants that no assignment, sale, agreement or encumbrance has been or will be made or entered into which would conflict with this assignment and sale.

ASSIGNOR further covenants that ASSIGNEE will, upon its request, be provided promptly with all pertinent facts and documents relating to said application, said invention and said Letters Patent as may be known and accessible to ASSIGNOR and ASSIGNOR will testify as to the same in any interference or litigation related thereto and will promptly execute and deliver to ASSIGNEE or its legal representative any and all papers, instruments or affidavits required to apply for, obtain, maintain and enforce said applications, said invention and said Letters Patent which may be necessary or desirable to carry out the purposes hereof.
