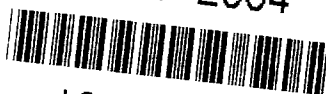

DELEGATED ADMINISTRATION FOR A DISTRIBUTED SECURITY SYSTEM


