
# ASSIGNMENT

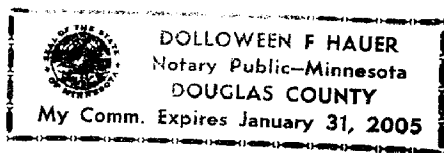


