ASSIGNOR agrees without charge to said ASSIGNEE but at ASSIGNEE's expense (a) to obtain execution of (i) all necessary papers to be used in connection with the above assigned rights, as the ASSIGNEE may deem necessary or expedient, (ii) all papers in connection with any interference or other legal or quasi-legal proceedings relating to these assigned rights, (iii) all papers and documents which may be necessary in connection with the preparation and filing of any above assigned foreign applications or with making claims to priority rights granted under the provisions of the International Convention for Protection of Industrial Property or similar agreements; (b) to cooperate with ASSIGNEE in every way possible in obtaining evidence and going forward in any such proceedings; and (c) to perform all other affirmative acts which may be necessary or desirable to obtain a grant of a valid patent over the assigned rights in any country throughout the world.

ASSIGNOR hereby authorizes and requests the Commissioner of Patents of the United States, and the appropriate officials in any other country, to issue any and all Letters Patent that may be granted upon any patent application or any additional, continuing or divisional applications thereof to the ASSIGNEE, its successors and/or assigns.


