Sole Inventor

WHEREAS Charles L. Van Auken, County of York, State of PA, hereinafter called the "Assignor", has invented certain new and useful improvements in RAILWAY TRUCK PEDESTAL BEARING ADAPTER, for a full description of which reference is here made to the attached application for Letters Patent of the United States (Docket No. 6263).

right, title and interest in and to said invention and application for Letters Patent and Letters Patent therefor in all countries foreign to the United States; to have and to hold for the sole and exclusive use and benefit of the said Assignees, their successors, assigns and legal representatives, to the full end of the term or terms for which any and all of said Letters Patent for said invention may issued.

And the said Assignor does hereby covenant and agree, for himself and his legal representatives, that he will assist the said Assignees in the prosecution of the application herein identified; in the making and prosecution of any other application for Letters Patent that the said Assignees may elect to make covering the invention herein identified, as hereinbefore set forth; in vesting in the said Assignees like exclusive title in and to all such other applications and Letters Patent; and in the prosecution of any interference which may arise involving said invention, or any application or Letters Patent herein contemplated; and that he will execute and deliver to the said Assignees any and all additional papers which may be requested by the said Assignees to fully carry out the terms of this assignment.

And the said Assignor does hereby covenant with said Assignees, their successors, assigns and legal representatives that the rights and property herein conveyed are free and clear of any adverse assignment, grant, mortgage, license or other encumbrance, and that he has the full right to convey to the same in manner and form as herein expressed.

And the said Assignor hereby authorizes and requests the Commissioner of Patents and Trademarks to issue said Letters Patent to said Assignees as the joint owners of an undivided interest in and to said Letters Patent and the inventions described and claimed therein.

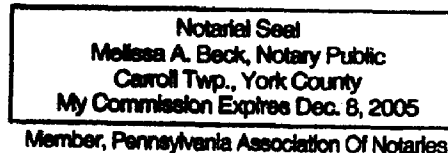
