INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY ASSIGNMENT

This Assignment by and between HENKEL CORPORATION, a corporation organized under the laws of the State of Delaware (hereinafter "ASSIGNOR") and HENKEL Kommanditgesellschaft auf Aktien, a partnership limited by shares organized under the laws of the Federal Republic of Germany (hereinafter "ASSIGNEE").

PREAMBLE

ASSIGNOR has agreed to sell to ASSIGNEE, and ASSIGNEE has agreed to purchase from ASSIGNOR, all those of ASSIGNOR'S patents, patent applications, and inventions, and all those of ASSIGNOR'S trademarks and registrations and applications therefor, worldwide, which relate to ASSIGNOR'S Surface Technologies Business (hereinafter the "HST IP Intangibles").

ASSIGNMENT

For good and valuable consideration, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, ASSIGNOR hereby sells, assigns and transfers to ASSIGNEE, its successors and assigns, as of the Effective Dates set forth below, the entire right, title, and interest in the HST IP Intangibles, including without limitation the HST Patents and Patent Application listed in Schedule A attached hereto (hereinafter the "Assigned Patents") and the Trademark Registrations and Applications listed in Schedule B attached hereto (hereinafter the "Assigned Trademarks"), for the full terms thereof and any renewals thereof, including all goodwill associated with the trademarks and including the right to legally pursue any past, present or future infringement or unauthorized use of said Patents and Trademarks, such Patents and Trademarks to be held and enjoyed by ASSIGNEE, its successors and assigns, as fully and entirely as the same would have been held and enjoyed by ASSIGNOR had this assignment and sale not been made.

This Assignment shall be effective as of January 1, 2002 for Assigned Trademarks except for those which are set forth in Schedule C attached hereto which assignments shall be effective as of April 15, 2002, and this Assignment shall be effective as of January 1, 2002 for all other HST IP Intangibles.
