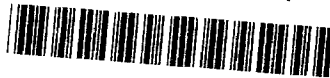

**ASSIGNMENT**

WHEREAS, Charles C. Frost, Jonathan M. Rathbun and Ryan L. 


