THE ASSIGNOR, PPT VISION, INC., a Minnesota corporation, having its principal place of business at 12988 Valley View Road, Eden Prairie, MN 55344, is the owner of a new and useful invention known as METHOD AND APPARATUS FOR AN L.E.D. FLASHLIGHT as described in United States Patent Number 6,095,661 issued August 1, 2000, METHOD AND APPARATUS FOR L.E.D. ILLUMINATION as described in United States Patent Number 6,305,818 issued October 23, 2001, COLOR-ADJUSTED CAMERA LIGHT AND METHOD as described in United States Patent Number 6,488,390 issued December 3, 2002, METHOD AND APPARATUS FOR A PULSED L.E.D. ILLUMINATION SOURCE as described in United States Patent Application Number 10/299,609 filed November 18, 2002, and METHOD AND APPARATUS FOR A VARIABLE INTENSITY PULSED L.E.D. LIGHT as described in United States Patent Application Number (10/945,801) filed September 20, 2004; (together called "the Patented Technology") and

THE ASSIGNEE, CHARLES A. LEMAIRE, an individual residing at 13195 Flamingo Court, Apple Valley, MN 55124, wishes to acquire the entire right, title and interest in and to the invention and the patents for this invention.

FOR VALUABLE AND LEGALLY SUFFICIENT CONSIDERATIONS, RECEIPT OF WHICH IS HEREBY ACKNOWLEDGED, the Assignor sells, assigns, and transfers to Assignee, his successors and assigns, the entire right, title and interest for the United States in and to the above-identified invention including the right to claim priority, and, for their full terms, each of the Letters Patent, the applications for Letters Patent, and all patents, continuations, divisions, reexaminations, restorations, extensions, reissues, substitutions and continuations-in-part therefrom and all Letters Patent which may be granted therefrom in the United States for the invention (collectively, the Patents), together with all claims by Assignor for damages by reason of past infringement of the Patents with the right to sue for and collect the same for Assignee's own use and benefit, and for the use and benefit of his successors, assigns and other legal representatives, except only that Assignee grants back a perpetual, non-exclusive, royalty-free, non-transferrable, worldwide license (without right to sublicense or assign) to Assignor to make, have made, use, sell, offer to sell, and import the Patented Technology covered by the Patents but only as applied to providing illumination for machine-vision cameras and systems made by Assignor. This grant-back license shall expire upon acquisition of Assignor by a third party, or by entry into the bankruptcy by Assignor, or by any assignment or sublicense of rights under the grant-back license. Nothing in this grant-back license to Assignor or otherwise in this agreement shall expressly or impliedly give Assignor the right to license the Patents to others.

The Assignor also sells, assigns, and transfers to Assignee Assignor's entire right, title, and interest in and to the invention and applications for Letters Patent and Letters Patent therefore in countries foreign to the United States, including all rights under the International Convention. The Assignor further authorizes Assignee to apply for Letters Patent in foreign countries in the name of the Assignee, and to claim priority to the filing date of the United States Application under the provision of International Convention.

The Assignor further agrees, for itself and its legal representatives, to assist Assignee in the prosecution before the United States Patent Office and the Federal Courts of any matters relating to the Invention and the Patents and other applications for Letters Patent, including renewals, continuations, divisions, reissues, and substitutions, that the Assignee elects to make covering the invention. The Assignor vests in the Assignee like exclusive title in and to all other such applications and Letters Patent. The Assignor will execute and deliver to Assignee any documents which may be requested by Assignee to carry out the terms of this Assignment.

The Commissioner of Patents of the United States is authorized and requested to recognize Assignee as the owner of United States Patent Numbers 6,095,661, 6,305,818, and 6,488,390, and United States Patent Application Numbers 10/299,609 and 10/945,801. The Assignor also authorizes and requests the equivalent authorities in foreign countries to issue the Patents of foreign countries to Assignee as requested.

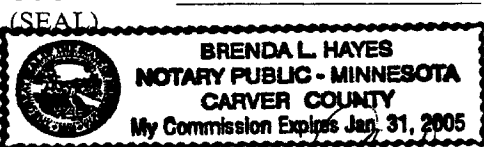
