

**ASSIGNMENT
(JOINT-EXECUTIVE ORDER)**

WHEREAS, we, **Christopher W. Mutz and Leonid I. Perlovsky**, while employed by the Government of the United States, made an invention, entitled **DYNAMIC LOGIC ALGORITHM USED FOR DETECTING SLOW-MOVING OR CONCEALED TARGETS IN SYNTHETIC APERTURE RADAR (SAR) IMAGES** and described in application for Letters Patent of the United States executed by us on or about the 4 day of MAY, 2004 and on the 4 day of MAY, 2004.

WHEREAS, the conditions under which said invention was made are such as to entitle the Government under Paragraph 1(a) of Executive Order 10096, to the entire right, title and interest therein, including foreign rights; and

WHEREAS, as to foreign rights, it is the policy of the Government to obtain an option to exercise such rights;

NOW, THEREFORE, to all whom it may concern, be it known that for and in consideration of the premises and other valuable considerations, we, **Christopher W. Mutz and Leonid I. Perlovsky**, joint inventors, have sold, assigned and transferred and by these presents do sell, assign and transfer unto the Government of the United States of America as represented by the Secretary of the Air Force, our entire right, title and interest throughout the world, in and to the aforesaid invention described in the aforesaid application for Letters Patent of the United States, and all Letters Patent issuing thereon and any continuations, continuations-in-part, divisions and reissues or extensions thereof; we hereby authorize and request the Commissioner of Patents and Trademarks to issue said Letters Patent to the Government of the United States of America, as represented by the Secretary of the Air Force, and his/her successors, as assignee of our entire right, title and interest in and to the same throughout the United States of America, its territories and dependencies, for the sole use for the full term or terms for which said Letters Patent and any continuations, including continuations-in-part, divisions and reissues or extensions thereof are, or may be granted as fully and entirely as the same would have been held by us, **Christopher W. Mutz and Leonid I. Perlovsky**, had this assignment not been made; and we do hereby also grant unto the Government of the United States as represented by the Secretary of the Air Force, our right, title and interest in said invention or all applications for Letters Patent thereon in all countries foreign to the United States in which the Government of the United States may file, or cause to be filed, applications for Letters Patent, without payment to us of any further consideration; provided, however, that this grant to take foreign rights in our invention, or applications for Letters Patent thereon, shall have force and effect only as to such applications filed in foreign countries, within six months of the filing date of any application herein, and that all foreign rights not exercised under this grant are left to us subject to a nonexclusive, irrevocable, royalty-free license to the Government of the United States in any patent which may issue
