RENOUNCEMENT OF ASSIGNMENT

WHEREAS, Joseph J. Karchesy (hereinafter "KARCHESY"), of Corvallis, Oregon, a citizen of the United States of America, was not employed by and not under an obligation to assign rights to The Government of the United States of America as Represented by the Secretary of the Department of Health and Human Services, Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (hereinafter "THE GOVERNMENT"), during the time when he contributed to the invention entitled "COMPOUNDS FOR PEST CONTROL AND METHODS FOR THEIR USE" and disclosed in:

WHEREAS, KARCHESY was named as an applicant in the above-identified patent applications and KARCHESY executed an assignment of the invention on October 17, 2003 ("the October 2003 Assignment"), to THE GOVERNMENT, Technology Transfer Office, 4770 Buford Hwy (K79), Atlanta GA 30341, which assignment was recorded with the United States Patent and Trademark Office at Reel 014671, Frames 0541-0554, on November 10, 2003;

WHEREAS, it subsequently came to the attention of THE GOVERNMENT that at the time KARCHESY executed that assignment, he was not under an obligation to assign the invention to THE GOVERNMENT, and did not have the authority to assign his rights to THE GOVERNMENT contrary to his obligation of assignment to his employer;


