ASSIGNMENT

WHEREAS, I, Daniel H. Zimmerman, a United States citizen residing at 5527 Oakmont Avenue, Bethesda, Maryland 20878, (hereinafter Assignor) have invented certain new and useful improvements in METHODS OF PREPARATION AND COMPOSITION OF PEPTIDE CONSTRUCTS USEFUL FOR TREATMENT OF AUTOIMMUNE AND TRANSPLANT RELATED HOST VERSUS GRAFT CONDITIONS; for which an application for United States Patent has been signed by me on 12/7/04 and is filed concurrently herewith.

FURTHER, it is agreed that Assignor will communicate to Assignee or its representatives any facts known respecting said inventions, and testify in any legal proceedings, sign all lawful papers, execute all divisional, continuation, substitution, renewal and reissue applications, execute all necessary assignment papers to cause any and all of said Letters Patent to be issued, make all rightful oaths and generally do everything possible to aid in obtaining and enforcing proper protection for said Inventions in the United States and in any and all foreign countries.
