WHEREAS, we, Jonathan Jay Woolley (resident of Draper, Utah, whose postal mailing address is 519 E. High Berry Lane, Draper, Utah 84020), Roger T. Johnsen (resident of Salt Lake City, Utah, whose postal mailing address is 1866 E. London Plane Road , Salt Lake City, Utah 84124), Mark J. Morgan (resident of Draper, Utah, whose postal mailing address is 522 E. High Berry Lane, Draper, Utah 84020), and Steven C. Hart (resident of Coeur D'Alene, Idaho, whose postal mailing address is 302 W. We hereby agree, without further consideration and without expense to us, to sign all lawful papers and to perform all other lawful acts which the Assignee may request of us to make this Assignment fully effective, including, by way of example but not of limitation, the following: prompt execution of all original, divisional, substitution, reissue, and other United States and foreign patent applications on said invention, and all lawful documents as requested by the Assignee to further the prosecution of any of such patent applications; cooperation to the best of our ability including, but not limited to, the execution of all lawful documents, the production of evidence in any actions or proceedings concerning the invention, including, but not limited to, nullification, reissuing, extension, and infringement proceedings involving said invention.

This assignment and agreement shall be binding upon our heirs and legal representatives.

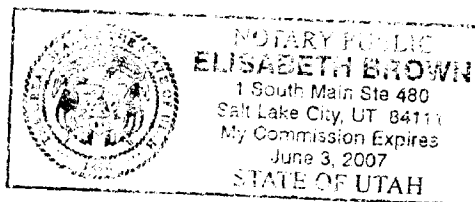
