THIS ASSIGNMENT, effective the 27th day of May, 2004, is made by and between **KIMBERLY-CLARK WORLDWIDE INC.** (Assignor), a Delaware corporation, and **Barry J. Marshall** (Assignee), an individual, a citizen of Australia.

WHEREAS, the Assignor is the owner, by assignment, of the entire right, title and interest in and to certain United States Letters Patent, United States Patent Applications and corresponding foreign patents and patent applications, and the inventions disclosed and claimed therein, as identified on Exhibit A hereto, which is incorporated herein by reference (referred to individually and collectively herein as the "Patent Rights"); and

WHEREAS, the Assignee is interested in acquiring ownership of the Application from the Assignor, and the Assignor is interested in transferring ownership of the Patent Rights to the Assignee.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Assignor, in consideration of the payment by the Assignee to the Assignors of the sum of One U.S. Dollar (\$1.00) and for other good and valuable consideration, the receipt, adequacy and sufficiency of which is acknowledged by the Assignor:

1. Hereby assigns and transfers to the Assignee, its successors and assigns, Assignor's entire right, title and interest in and to the aforesaid Patent Rights in any form or embodiment thereof, and in and to the aforesaid Patent Rights along with the right to sue for past infringement and in and to each and every invention described in the Patent Rights, and in and to any and all applications for Letters Patent filed in countries foreign to the United States for the inventions of the Patent Rights, and any and all Letters Patents which may be granted for the inventions of the Patent Rights in the foreign countries, to have and to hold the same to the full end of the term or terms for which any and all the Letters Patents may be granted.
2. Authorizes and requests the Commissioner of Patents and Trademarks to issue Letters Patent of the United States to the Assignee of the entire right, title and interest in and to the inventions of the Patent Rights.
3. Will make available, at Assignee's request and at Assignee's expense, the inventor(s) of any Patent Rights to the extent that the inventor(s) is still an employee or under the control of Assignor, to testify in any interference, opposition or other legal proceeding, and to sign all papers, execute all divisional, continuing and reissue applications, and to make all rightful oaths and generally do everything possible to aid the Assignee, its successors, assigns or other legal representatives, to obtain and enforce any and all patents that may issue from Patent Rights and for which they are an inventor.

4. Will, at any time and upon request and at the expense of Assignee, execute and deliver or cause to be executed and delivered by inventor(s) still within its employ or under its control, any and all papers that may be necessary or desirable to perfect the title to the Patent Rights or any Letters Patent that may issue therefrom in the United States or countries foreign to the United States on behalf of Assignee, its successors, assigns or other legal representatives, and the Assignor will, at any time upon request, communicate to the Assignee, its successors, assigns or other legal representatives, such facts relating to the invention described in the Patent Rights or the history of the Patent Rights or the history of the Patent Rights as may be known to it.
