WHEREAS, Azorides R. Morales (hereinafter the ASSIGNOR) has made an invention entitled "SIMPLIFIED TISSUE PROCESSING" for which patent applications were filed on October 25, 2004 in the Patent and Trademark Office as U.S. Appln. any Letters Patent resulting therefrom, together with the right of priority under the International Convention for the Protection of Industrial Property, the Inter-American Convention Relating to Patents, Designs and Industrial Models, and any other international agreements to which the United States of America adheres; and ASSIGNOR hereby authorizes and requests the Commissioner of Patents to issue said Letters Patent to ASSIGNEE, for its interest as ASSIGNEE, its successors, assigns, and legal representatives;

ASSIGNOR hereby agrees to execute any papers by ASSIGNEE, its successors, assigns, and legal representatives, which are deemed essential to ASSIGNEE'S full protection and title in and to the invention hereby assigned; and

ASSIGNOR hereby agrees, upon request of ASSIGNEE, and without further remuneration, to execute any and all papers desired by ASSIGNEE, for the filing and granting of foreign applications and the perfecting of title thereto in ASSIGNEE.


