## PATENT ASSIGNMENT

This PATENT ASSIGNMENT effective as of June 14, 2005, is made by John Pertessis, residing at 1461 Mabrey Court, Thousand Oaks, California 91380 (“Assignor”), to John Pertessis and Susan Spadoni Pertessis, Trustees of the Pertessis Family Trust dated June 14, 2005 (“Assignee”).

WHEREAS, Assignor is the sole inventor of a new and useful **METHOD AND APPARATUS FOR STARTING MOTORS**, for which U.S. Application No. 08/877,737 for United States Letters Patent was filed on June 17, 1997, which patent application matured into U.S. Patent No. 6,034,503 granted March 7, 2000, as set forth in the attached Schedule A (the “Patent”); and

WHEREAS, Assignor, for the sole purpose of changing formal title, desires to transfer and assign to Assignee, without consideration, all his right, title and interest in and to the Patent, including the right to file continuations-in-part in the United States and any patents thereof throughout the world, including the right to file foreign applications directly in the name of the Assignee and to claim for any such foreign applications any priority rights to which such applications are entitled under international conventions, treaties or otherwise.

NOW, THEREFORE, Assignor hereby assigns and transfers to Assignee, his entire right, title and interest in and to the Patent, together with all rights of Assignor associated therewith, including the right to file continuations-in-part in the United States and any patents thereof throughout the world, including the right to file foreign applications directly in the name of the Assignee and to claim for any such foreign applications any priority rights to which such applications are entitled under international conventions, treaties or otherwise.




