

ASSIGNMENT OF PATENT RIGHTS

This Assignment of Patent Rights (the "Agreement") is entered into as of this 14th day of April, 2005 (the "Closing Date"), by and between Mr. Michael Brunn, an individual residing at 14 Winding Way, Sea Cliff, NY 11579 ("Assignor") and Combined Tactical Systems, Inc., a Pennsylvania corporation ("Assignee").

WHEREAS, Assignor (a) is the owner of various United States patents, patent applications and foreign patents and patent applications or (b) has previously assigned to the Assignee various United States patents, patent applications and foreign patents and patent applications, including, but not limited to, in the case of both clause (a) and clause (b), those specified in Schedule A attached hereto (collectively, the "Patent Rights");

WHEREAS, Assignee is desirous of acquiring the entire and exclusive right, title and interest in and to the Patent Rights and the inventions disclosed therein and improvements to such inventions, in the United States and throughout the world;

WHEREAS, Assignor is willing to assign to Assignee all rights, title and interest in and to the Patent Rights, and the inventions disclosed therein and improvements to such inventions, in the United States and throughout the world; and

NOW, THEREFORE, for good and valuable consideration, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged by Assignor, Assignor hereby assigns, transfers and conveys to Assignee, its successors, legal representatives and assigns, and Assignee hereby accepts, all of Assignor's right, title and interest in the United States and throughout the world in and to the Patent Rights, the inventions disclosed therein and improvements to such inventions and all existing and future modifications and improvements thereon, and any and all Letters Patent that are or may be granted thereon, and any legal equivalent thereof that may be granted in any country or countries foreign to the United States, in each case including without limitation any extensions, substitutes, continuations, continuations-in-part, divisions, reissues, reexaminations, and renewals thereof, or other equivalents thereof, and further, all rights and privileges pertaining to the Patent Rights and any and all Letters Patent that are or may be granted thereon, and any legal equivalent thereof that may be granted in any country or countries foreign to the United States, including, without limitation, the right, if any, to petition, sue or otherwise seek and recover damages, profits and any other remedy (monetary, injunctive, declaratory or other) in the United States and anywhere throughout the world for any past, present and future infringement thereof, conversion or misappropriation of, or other injury, offense, violation, breach of duty or wrong relating to, any of the Patent Rights, or any license, agreement, contract or other matter relating thereto.

Assignor further assigns to and empowers Assignee, its successors, assigns or nominees, all rights to make applications for patents or other forms of protection for said inventions, modifications and improvements and to prosecute such applications as well as the right to claim priority without further written or oral authorization.

Assignor hereby authorizes and requests the Commissioner of Patents and Trademarks of the United States of America and the appropriate officers of all other jurisdictions in which the

Patent Rights are or may be registered or in which applications included among the Patent Rights are pending, to record the title of Assignee, its successors, legal representatives and assigns, as owner of all right, title and interest in and to the Patent Rights, and to issue to Assignee, its successors, legal representatives and assigns, all Letters Patent and any legal equivalent thereof that may be granted in any country or countries foreign to the United States and recordings of patent rights resulting from any application included among the Patent Rights, in accordance with the terms of this instrument.

Assignor further agrees that Assignor will, without charge to Assignee, but at Assignee's expense: (a) cooperate with Assignee in the prosecution of United States and foreign patent applications on the inventions and any modifications and improvements; (b) execute, verify, acknowledge and deliver, or cause to be executed, verified, acknowledged and delivered, all such further papers, including without limitation patent applications and instruments of transfer; and (c) perform such other acts as Assignee lawfully may request to obtain, maintain, defend or enforce Letters Patent and any legal equivalent thereof for the inventions, modifications and improvements in any and all countries, and to vest title thereto in Assignee, or Assignee's legal representatives, or successors and assigns.

In the event that Assignee is unable for any reason whatsoever to secure Assignor's signature to any document it is entitled to under the preceding paragraph, Assignor hereby irrevocably designates and appoints Assignee and its duly authorized officers and agents, as Assignor's agents and attorneys-in-fact to act for and on Assignor's behalf and instead of Assignor, to execute and file any such document and to do all other lawfully permitted acts to further the purposes of the foregoing with the same legal force and effect as if executed by Assignor.

Assignor represents and warrants that: (i) Assignor has all rights necessary to make the assignment herein; (ii) Assignor has not assigned any right, title or interest in the rights assigned herein to any person or entity other than the Assignee; and (iii) this assignment does not conflict with any other agreement or other instrument to which Assignor is bound.

Except to the extent that federal law preempts state law with respect to the matters covered hereby, this Agreement shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, without giving effect to the principles of conflicts of laws thereof.

This Agreement shall be binding on, and shall inure to the benefit of, the parties hereto and their respective successors and assigns.


Each party represents that it has taken all necessary action to authorize the execution and delivery of this Agreement.




