

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ASSIGNMENT OF PATENT APPLICATION

WHEREAS, I, JORGE L. ACOSTA, a citizen of THE UNITED STATES (hereinafter referred to as "ASSIGNOR"), have invented a certain invention entitled DENSE PATTERN OPTICAL SCANNER for which application for Letters Patent of the United States of America has been filed on August 30, 2000, assigned Serial No. 09/650,882; and
