1.2 all such rights as she may have to apply for prosecute and obtain patents and other Intellectual property protection anywhere in the world in respect of the Inventions to the intent that the grant of any patents or other Intellectual property protection for the Inventions shall be in the name of and shall vest in the Assignee or its successors or assigns;

1.3 all such rights as she may have to claim priority from any of the patent applications in any and all applications for patent protection for the Inventions;


