## **Patent Assignment**

THIS PATENT ASSIGNMENT is made and entered into as of the 18th day of January, 2005, between FPR Corp., a New Hampshire Corporation ("Assignor"), and BAE SYSTEMS Information and Electronic Systems Integration Inc., a Delaware corporation ("Assignee").

WHEREAS, Assignor is the owner of the entire right, title and interest in and has the unrestricted right to sell, assign and transfer the following patents (the "Patents");

- US Patent Number 5,859,930; "Fast Pattern Recognizer Utilizing Dispersive Delay Line"
- US Patent Number 6,075,898; "Reflective Array Compressor"

WHEREAS, pursuant to the terms of a Collaboration Agreement dated as of November 22, 2004, by and between Assignor and Assignee, Assignor agreed, among other things, to transfer to Assignee, an undivided one-half right, title and interest in the said patents.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the premises and mutual covenants set forth in the Collaboration Agreement, Assignor hereby sells, assigns, transfers and sets over to Assignee, its successors and permitted assigns, an undivided one-half right, title and interest in and to the patents identified above, including (without limitation) all divisions, reissues, substitutions, continuations and extensions thereof, all priority rights under the International Convention for the Protection of Industrial Property for every member country (and any other international convention or treaty), any and all Letters Patent and reissues and extensions of Letters Patent granted thereon and any and all rights corresponding to any of the foregoing throughout the world, and any and all accounts, contract rights, warranties, litigation claims and rights, including the right to sue for and collect upon all claims for profits and damages as a result of past infringement, if any, and other general intangibles of Assignor related to any of the foregoing, in each case whether now existing or hereafter acquired or created, whether owned, leased or licensed beneficially or of record and whether owned, leased or licensed individually, jointly or otherwise, together with the products and proceeds thereof (including license royalties and the proceeds of infringement suits), all payments and other distributions with respect thereto and any divisions, reissues, substitutions, continuations, and extensions of any and all of the foregoing.

Assignor further agrees that it shall on the date hereof and from time to time thereafter, at the request of Assignee, perform or cause to be performed such acts and execute, acknowledge and deliver at the request of Assignee, such documents as may reasonably be required to evidence or effectuate the sale, conveyance, assignment, transfer and delivery to Assignee of the patents and patent applications or for the performance by Assignor of any of its obligations hereunder.
