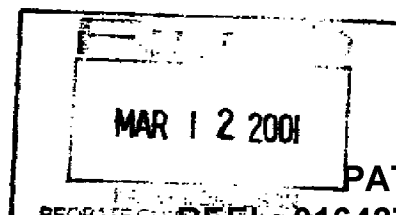

**JUDGMENT, ORDER AND DECREE**

NOW, on this 12<sup>th</sup> of ~~February~~<sup>March</sup>, 2001, the issues joined by the Claim of Shirley Carlson and the Claim of Jan Shuster were submitted to the Court by all parties in interest for determination based on the Claims filed herein and the Agreement entered into by and between all parties in interest and such other relief that the Court finds meet and just.

The Court finds and determines as follows:

1. That an estate was not opened for decedent within the period allowed by law.
2. That, at the time of his death, decedent was not survived by a spouse or minor children.
3. That, at the time of his death, decedent was the owner of, or entitled to possession of, the following items of personal property:
  - a. A certain 8 X 10 storage building valued at \$900.00.
  - b. A 1994 Dodge pick-up, VIN 1B7KF26CXRS558329, valued at \$6,000.00.
  - c. A 1974 Airstream travel trailer, VIN 13184J3081 valued at \$2,000.00.
  - d. A 1992 Ford truck, VIN 1FTJX35G8NKA91893, valued at \$4,000.00 (trade in).



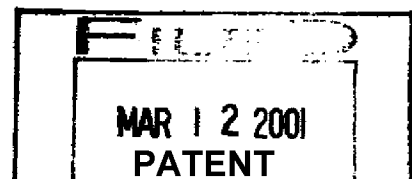
- e. A 16' enclosed IRVI trailer, Serial # "...6245", valued at \$1,000.00.
  - f. Intellectual Property rights covered by U.S. Patents 4309594, 4197447, and 5925320. With no discernable value.
4. That, further, decedent was the sole owner of all of the shares of the following corporations:
- a. Sun Twin Corporation, #00309956, administratively dissolved on March 11, 2000, with no discernable value.
  - b. Indoor Air Technology, LTD, a Bahamian Corporation, with no discernable value.
5. That the Estate of John Paul Jones is indebted to Jan Shuster in the amount of \$284,547.29; and is indebted to Shirley Carlsen in the amount of \$12,000.00.
6. That John Paul Jones was the sole shareholder of Sun Twin Corporation, a Missouri Corporation administratively dissolved, and Indoor Air Technology, LTD, a Bahamian Corporation. The Court finds that Sun Twin Corporation and Indoor Air Technology LTD are not actively engaged in business activities and have no assets not disclosed herein with which to conduct manufacturing activities. That, in the interest of justice, the Court finds it prudent to transfer said corporations' interest in that certain 1994 Dodge pickup, 1974 Airstream travel trailer, 1992 Ford truck, and 16' enclosed trailer to the Estate of John Paul Jones for distribution in satisfaction of claims against the Estate. That the stock (ownership) of Indoor Air Technology LTD is an asset of the Estate without monetary value except for intellectual property rights

under patent number 5925320, which has reportedly been assigned to Indoor Air Technology LTD. That there are insufficient assets to satisfy the existing claims against the Estate.

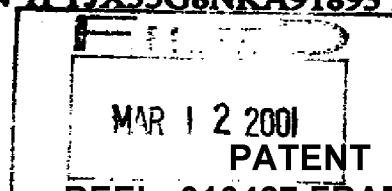
7. That the parties, Shirley Carlson and Jan Shuster, have entered into an agreement as to the distribution of the assets, subject to court approval, and a copy of said agreement is attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and incorporated herein by reference as fully as if set out in haec verba.

WHEREFORE, the Court hereby Orders, Adjudges, and Decrees:

1. That the claims filed by Jan B. Shuster and Shirley Carlsen against the Estate of John Paul Jones shall be satisfied by this Order.
2. The Court hereby transfers the assets of Sun Twin Corporation to the Estate of John Paul Jones for the purpose of satisfying the claims against the Estate..
3. The Court hereby transfers to Jan B. Shuster in satisfaction of his claim against the Estate of John Paul Jones the following properties:
  - a. A 1974 Airstream Travel Trailer, VIN 13184J3081, and the contents thereof, if any.
  - b. That certain 16' enclosed trailer, Serial # "...6245" and the contents thereof, if any.
  - c. The stock and ownership of Indoor Air Technology LTD and the assets thereof, if any.



- d. A non-exclusive license in the intellectual property covered by U.S. patent numbers 4309594, 4197447, and 5925320, pursuant to which Jan B. Shuster shall be entitled to market products under said patents without restriction.
  - e. Ownership of U.S. Patent Number 5925320.
  - f. That certain 8x10 storage building and the contents thereof, if any.
4. The Court hereby awards to Shirley Carlsen in satisfaction of her claim against the Estate of John Paul Jones the following properties:
- a. That certain 1994 Dodge pick-up, VIN 1B7KF26CXRS558329.
  - b. That certain 1992 Ford truck, VIN 1FTJX35G8NKA91893.
  - c. A non-exclusive license in the intellectual property covered by U.S. patent numbers 4309594, 4197447, and 5925320, pursuant to which Shirley Carlsen shall be entitled to market products under said patents without restriction.
5. U.S. Patents 4309594 and 4197447 are hereby assigned jointly and severally to Shirley Carlsen and Jan B. Shuster.
6. The Probate Court directs the Missouri Department of Revenue to issue a motor vehicle title and license to the 1994 Dodge pick-up, VIN 1B7KF26CXRS558329 in the name of Shirley Carlsen upon her application therefor upon sight of certified copy of this Order.
7. The Probate Court directs the Missouri Department of Revenue to issue a motor vehicle title and license to the 1992 Ford truck, VIN 1FTJX35G8NKA91893 in the




name of Shirley Carlsen upon her application therefor upon sight of a certified copy of this Order.

8. The Probate Court directs the Missouri Department of Revenue to issue a motor vehicle license to thye 1974 Airstream Travel Trailer, VIN 13184J3081 in the name of Jan B. Shuster upon his application therefor upon sight of a certified copy of this Order.
9. The Court directs the Missouri Department of Revenue to issue title to the 16" enclosed trailer, Serial # "...6245" in the name of Jan B. Shuster upon his application therefor upon sight of a certified copy of this Order.
10. A certified copy of this Order shall be sufficient to pass title and ownership of the property and assets awarded herein.
