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**RELEASE AND ASSIGNMENT OF
PATENT, TRADEMARK AND COPYRIGHT SECURITY AGREEMENT**

WHEREAS, pursuant to that certain Patent, Trademark and Copyright Security Agreement dated as of February 22, 2001 (the "Original Intellectual Property Security Agreement"), as amended by (i) that certain First Amendment to Patent, Trademark and Copyright Agreement dated April 10, 2001 (the "First Amendment to Intellectual Property Security Agreement") and (ii) that certain Second Amendment to Patent, Trademark and Copyright Agreement dated August 27, 2004 (the "Second Amendment to Intellectual Property Security Agreement" and, collectively with the Original Intellectual Property Security Agreement and the First Amendment to Intellectual Property Security Agreement, the "Intellectual Property Security Agreement"), by Michaels of Oregon Co., an Oregon corporation, and Mike's Holding Company, an Oregon corporation, (collectively the "Assignors" and each an "Assignor"), in favor of U.S. Bank National Association, a national banking association ("Original Collateral Agent"), and further amended by that certain Assignment of Patent, Trademark and Copyright Agreement dated March 25, 2004, in which Original Collateral Agent assigned its interest in the Intellectual Property Security Agreement to General Electric Capital Corporation, a Delaware corporation ("Subsequent Collateral Agent"), ("Assignment of Intellectual Property Security Agreement").

WHEREAS, (i) the Original Intellectual Property Security Agreement was recorded with the United States Patent and Trademark Office ("USPTO") and the United States Copyright Office ("USCO") (a) with respects to the Patents on March 1, 2001, at Reel 011575, Frame 0297, (b) with respects to Trademarks on March 1, 2001, at Reel 002251, Frame 0963, and (c) with respects to the Copyrights on March 1, 2001, at Volume 3465, Page 916, (ii) the First Amendment to Intellectual Property Security Agreement, recorded with the USPTO with respects to Trademarks on April 17, 2001, at Reel 002292, Frame 0181, (iii) the Second Amendment to Intellectual Property Security Agreement, recorded (a) with the USPTO with respects to the Patents on September 9, 2004, Reel 015098, Frame 0441, (b) with the USPTO with respects to Trademarks on September 13, 2004, Reel 002934, Frame 0587, and with the USCO with respects to the Copyrights on September 17, 2004, at Volume 3515, Doc. No. 25, and (iv) the Assignment of Intellectual Property Security Agreement was recorded (a) with the USPTO with respects to the Patents on April 7, 2004, at Reel 014499, Frame 0282, (b) with the USPTO with respects to Trademarks on April 7, 2004, Reel 002824, Frame 0826, and (c) with the USCO with respects to the Copyrights on April 13, 2004, at Volume 3509, Doc No. 285;

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Intellectual Property Security Agreement and the Assignment of Intellectual Property Security Agreement, each Assignor granted to Original Collateral Agent and Subsequent Collateral Agent a security interest in and lien on all of such Assignor's interest in and to the Intellectual Property Collateral as defined therein, including without limitation, (1) those Trademarks and Trademark Licenses as defined therein, (2) those Patents and Patent Licenses as defined therein, and (3) those Copyrights and Copyright Licenses as defined therein, all as more particularly described on the attached Schedule A, made a part hereof;




