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ASSIGNMENT

WHEREAS, David R. Booker, residing at 48 Newbury Street, Wantage, Oxon OX128DF, England (hereinafter referred to as "Assignor"), has invented certain new and useful improvements in an APPARATUS AND METHOD FOR ANALYSIS OF AEROSOLS for which an application for United States Letters Patent was filed on November 15, 2004, as United States patent application Serial No. 10/989,035, and which claims priority from United States provisional patent application Serial No. 60/519,699, filed on November 13, 2003.
