Launius, Jr., do hereby formally assign, transfer, and set over unto said Derby Worx, Inc., a corporation, its successors and assigns, all right, title, and interest in and to the aforesaid invention and patent application upon BODY TOOL, as fully and entirely as the same would have been held and enjoyed by me if this assignment and sale had not been made; and I agree to execute such further applications, powers of attorney, assignments and other documents as may be necessary or desirable to fully effectuate this agreement.


