
ASSIGNMENT OF PATENT APPLICATION

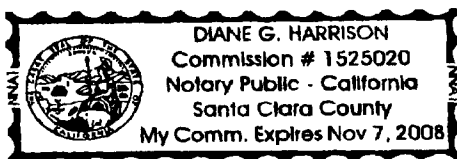
