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ASSIGNMENT

WHEREAS, Muneo HIKIDA, Masahiko MORI, Isao SAKATA, Susumu NAKAJIMA, and Hiroyuki TAKATA, citizens of Japan (hereinafter "INVENTORS"), invented certain new and useful improvements in IMINOCHLORINASPARTIC ACID DERIVATIVES, for which application for Letters Patent of the United States was filed as PCT application No. PCT/JP97/03484 (on September 30, 1997), and filed in the United States on June 15, 1999, serial No. 09/269,557, and which issued as U.S. patent No. 6,063,777 on May 16, 2000, and

WHEREAS, said INVENTORS assigned all their right, title, and interest in the United States in and to the aforesaid invention, and in, to and under any and all United States Patents to be obtained therefor to Wyeth Lederle Japan, Ltd. and Photochemical Co., Ltd. (Photochemical Co., Ltd., being hereinafter referred to as "ASSIGNOR"), by means of an Assignment dated March 17, 1999, and recorded in the U.S. Patent and Trademark Office on June 15, 1999, at Reel 010022, Frame 0570 (a change of name from Wyeth Lederle Japan, Ltd. to Wyeth K.K. having been recorded in the U.S. Patent and Trademark Office on January 29, 2004) at Reel 014934, Frame 0025; and

WHEREAS, Hamamatsu Photonics K.K. (hereinafter "ASSIGNEE"), a corporation of Japan, whose address is 1126-1, Ichino-cho, Hamamatsu-shi, Shizuoka 435-8558, Japan, is desirous of acquiring the entire right, title, and interest possessed by ASSIGNOR in and to the aforesaid invention, and

in, to, and under any and all Patents to be obtained therefor in the United States of America;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of One Dollar (\$1.00) and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged, ASSIGNOR, has and by these presents does hereby sell, assign and transfer unto said ASSIGNEE, its successors and assigns, its entire right, title and interest in and to said invention as described in said United States Patent Application and Patent in any form or embodiment thereof, and in and to the aforesaid Patent Application and Patent; also its entire right, title and interest in and to any and all reissues or extensions thereof to be obtained in the United States on said invention, and any divisional, continuation, continuation-in-part, or substitute applications which may be filed on said invention in the United States; and the issuing authority is hereby authorized and requested to issue any and all patents on said invention to said ASSIGNEE.

ASSIGNOR further agrees without any payment by ASSIGNEE, other than expenses incurred by ASSIGNOR, to communicate to ASSIGNEE, its representatives or agents, facts relating to said invention, including evidence for interference purposes or for other proceedings, whenever requested; to testify in any interference or other proceedings, whenever requested; and to execute and deliver on request all lawful papers required to make any of the foregoing provisions effective, and likewise

make these provisions binding upon any heirs, legal representatives, administrators and assigns, and ASSIGNOR hereby warrants that, at the time of execution and delivery of this instrument, it is the lawful owner of an undivided 50% interest in and to said invention and said Patent, and that the same are unencumbered and that it has good and full right and lawful authority to sell and convey the same in the manner herein set forth.


