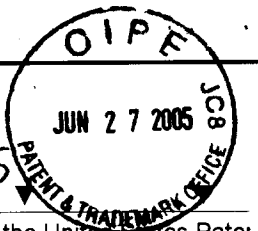

ASSIGNMENT

THIS ASSIGNMENT, effective as of July 16, 2004, made by Christopher J. Clarke of Burgess Hill, West Sussex, ENGLAND Assignor, to ALARIS Medical UK, Limited, a corporation under the laws of England and Wales, Assignee, located at The Crescent, Jays Close, Basingstoke, Hants RG22 4BS, U.K.

WHEREAS, Assignor has invented a new and useful AUTOMATIC CLAMP DEVICE WITH OFFSET RELEASE TAB for which an application for United States Letters Patent was filed on July 16, 2004 and has Application No. 29/209,509 and

WHEREAS, Assignor believes himself to be the original and first inventor of the invention disclosed and claimed in said application for Letters Patent; and
