ASSIGNMENT

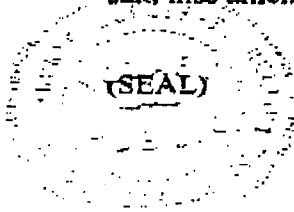


