

Recitals

- A. The Assignor owns the intellectual property described in the schedule to this deed (**Intellectual Property**).
- B. The Assignor has agreed to sell the Business including the Intellectual Property to the Assignee.
- C. The Assignor has agreed to assign to the Assignee all of the Assignor's interest in the Intellectual Property.

This deed witnesses

that in consideration of, among other things, the payment by the Assignee to the Assignor of A\$10, the receipt and sufficiency of which is acknowledged, the parties agree:

1 Definitions

1.1 Definitions

In this deed:

Business Sale Agreement means the contract of sale of the Business between the Assignor (as Seller) and the Assignee (as Buyer) dated on or about the date of this deed;

Terms used but not otherwise defined in this deed have the same meaning as in the Business Sale Agreement.

Assignment of patent assets

1.2 Interpretation

Clause 1.2 of the Business Sale Agreement applies in this agreement.

2 Assignment

- (a) The Assignor assigns to the Assignee:
 - (1) all of the Assignor's interest in the Intellectual Property; and
 - (2) the right to sue for damages and other remedies in respect of any infringement of the Intellectual Property which may have occurred before this assignment.
- (b) The Assignee accepts the assignment.

3 Registering this assignment and further action

- (a) The Assignee must promptly do all things necessary to have this assignment registered in any appropriate registry.
- (b) The Assignee must pay any fees or costs in relation to registering this assignment.
- (c) The Assignor must execute any documents and do any other things that the Assignee reasonably requests to:
 - (1) enable the Assignee to have its ownership of the Intellectual Property registered in any appropriate registry;
 - (2) enable the Assignee to file or prosecute in its name any application for a patent or other registration forming part of or relating to the Intellectual Property, whether in Australia or in any other country; or
 - (3) give effect to the terms of this deed.

4 Assignor must deliver materials

The Assignor must deliver to the Assignee on request all deeds of letters patent, certificates, title documents, technical information and records relating to the Intellectual Property in the possession or control of the Assignor, or the Receivers and Managers..

5 Limitations

5.1 Limitations on Liability

The Assignor and the Receivers and Managers have the same, and are subject no greater, liabilities or obligations under this deed than they are subject to under the Business Sale Agreement.

Assignment of patent assets

5.2 No Personal Liability

- (a) The Assignee acknowledges and agrees that:
- (1) the Receivers and Managers enter into this transaction and execute this deed solely in their capacity as Receivers and Managers and not in their personal capacity; and
 - (2) the Receivers and Managers incur no personal liability whatsoever under this deed except in the case of negligence, wilful misconduct, or breach of duty by the Receivers and Managers in their capacity as Receivers and Managers.
- (b) To avoid any doubt, if there is a breach of any express or implied provision of this deed, the Buyer acknowledges and agrees that it will not have any claim or action whatsoever against the Receivers and Managers, it being accepted by the Assignee that any claim or action must be taken solely against the Assignor company except in the case of negligence, wilful misconduct, or breach of duty by the Receivers and Managers in their capacity as Receivers and Managers.

6 Governing law and jurisdiction

- (a) This deed is governed by the laws of Queensland.
- (b) Each party irrevocably submits to the exclusive jurisdiction of the courts of Queensland.

7 Counterparts

- (a) This deed may be executed in any number of counterparts.
- (b) All counterparts, taken together, constitute one instrument.
- (c) A party may execute this deed by signing any counterpart.
- (d) A party may execute this deed, or any counterpart, by facsimile, and the facsimile will be accepted as an original.
